How Many Gallons Of Ice Cream Did We Use Last Semester?

Over the course of first semester Jitters went through quite a bit of supplies and for the first time ever we have kept track of exactly how much we have used. Every week an order is placed with our vendor SYSCO and through these records we were able to determine the insane amount of material we used. First lets start with whipped cream. To my surprise we only went through 120 cans of whipped cream during the fall semester, but don't worry, the

numbers get crazier. Next, it was determined that 144 bottles of syrup were used this fall. Next comes the Oreos. In crushed Oreos alone, Jitters used up 270 pounds worth. When you think about how few scoops go into each drink it is hard to imagine going through 270 pounds! Now finally we have gotten to the total gallons of ice cream. On average, Jitters was receiving over 29 containers of ice cream per order. In each week Jitters only has the potential to be open for 14 shifts so the fact

that we are ordering over 29 containers is quite impressive. However, in total during the fall semester, Jitters used a total of 1,050 gallons of ice cream! This was by far the most shocking total of the group. After seeing this unbelievable number Jitters is definitely planning on tracking supply totals in the future.

What was most memorable about this past semester?


This semester was my first at UWW. My time here in Whitewater, I have made new friends and gotten involved at Jitters and I work at Andersen Library.
